

These paper lanterns are easy and fun to make and are ideal for using with LED replaceable battery tealights. Group them together for more impact.



Time to make: 30 minutes

Suitable for: younger children with supervision

You will need:

Paper – you can use newspaper, wrapping paper, photocopier paper or coloured card

Scissors

Hole punch

Scotch tape

LED replaceable battery tealight

Pyramid lantern template

Easy Pyramid Paper Lanterns

Print and cut the paper/card

Begin by printing the template onto the paper or card you are using or trace round the template onto the card/paper. Cut out the lantern shape.



Punch holes

Use a hole punch to punch holes in the sides of the lantern then fold the corners up.



Using the longest piece of tape possible, place it on the INSIDE of the box and very, very carefully pull the opposite side up and seal tightly. You do not want light coming out of the edges, so take time to seal these well.

Carefully insert the LED candle.

Light Up Eden

Place your lantern in your window or doorstep at dusk on Saturday 20th March.
